What is it?

The GCP is partnering with local laundry facilities in Duval and Palm Beach Counties to launch an innovative program that will support preK-12 homeless and low-income students with professional wash and fold laundry services right from their schools. All students deserve to attend school in clean clothes for a better school experience.

Why Now?

- Low-income students without access to clean clothes: miss more school, attend school wearing dirty clothes, and/or experience bullying
- Access to washers/dryers in apartments is limited or non-existent
- Laundromats and transportation to, are an added cost for already struggling low-income families
- COVID-19 pandemic has been financially devastating for many low-income families
- Germs, bacteria, and smell can be passed through soiled clothing.
- Cleanliness in schools is now more important than ever before due to the coronavirus
