The Giving Closet Project (GCP), established in 2016, provides clothing and hygiene products to students in need, elevating their self-esteem and dignity. Its vision is to reduce barriers to student success including bullying, chronic absenteeism, and the inability to focus in the classroom. Headquartered in Jacksonville, FL, GCP serves children in both Duval and Palm Beach counties.

THE ESSENTIAL ANGELS PROGRAM



Upcycling unclaimed lost and found clothing from schools was how GCP started, but has blossomed into a dynamic and unique organization that continues to innovate and provide emergency wrap around services to homeless and low-income youth.

The Essential Angels program is a referral-based care package distribution system that provides clothing, hygiene items, and more to students in grades Pre-K through 12 who are experiencing homelessness and/or persistent or situational poverty. Teachers, social workers, and other

program through our online portal. The program provides one month's worth of hygiene products, a week's worth of clothes, along with shoes and a backpack.

THE EVER-GROWING NEED

The services we provide are unique in Florida. GCP partners with over hundreds of service agencies, schools, teachers, social workers, case managers, and other referring partners.

GCP provided \$600,000 worth of custom care packages to over 5,000 students last year alone. The demand for our services is high, and the needs of your constituents are growing exponentially.

GCP is dedicated to ensuring that ALL students have an opportunity to build their self-esteem, positively engage with their peers, improve academically, increase attendance, and receive the education they deserve.

WHO WE SERVE

Imagine an 8-year-old wanting to skip school only because their clothes are filthy and have not been washed in weeks or months. A special needs student who comes to school without socks or underwear under her jeans, which hurts and makes her walk slow and awkwardly because she is in pain. A student whose mom is a victim of domestic violence and she needs hygiene products including tampons. These are just a few of the children that GCP has helped recently.

"KT and her dad lost everything once he was injured at work. He is no longer able to provide the basic necessities."

"Benjamin is in fifth grade and needs any type of clothing if possible. He comes to school in clothes that are dirty and have holes in them. It breaks my heart to see him in clothing like this."

"Child lives with a single mom and one younger sibling. The parent works 2 jobs to make ends meet and often still falls short due to the high cost of living. Child's dad lives in another city in Florida and offers little to no financial assistance. The family values education. The parent enrolls the child in afterschool activities to offer activity and socialization."

"Youth is currently staying with a friend as we work with her to get her into an independent living program. In the fall she'll be going into her senior year and is in need of new uniforms."
